When the Taliban begins to round up all the boys to send them to a madrassa, Osama knows it is only a matter of time before her true identity is revealed. In the meantime the Shah of Iran died and the demand to expel him was dropped. The Iranian Parliament finally convened and was apparently willing to return the hostages. And then Saddam Hussein attacked Iran. In the US, Carter and Reagan were running neck and neck in the elections and Carter hoped that if he managed to bring hostages home he might gain ground.
