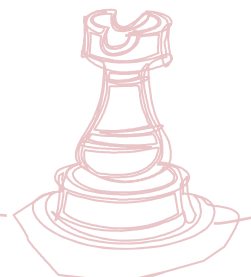

His Building Learning Power program has boosted young people's learning confidence and capacity in hundreds of schools across the UK, Australia and New Zealand. Guy has worked directly with teachers and policy-makers in every state of Australia. His 2008 book, highly praised by Howard Gardner, David Perkins, Susan Greenfield and Sir Ken Robinson, is called *What's the Point of School?*
