Drawing from over 300 items generously donated by Kylie Minogue to the Arts Centre's Performing Arts Collection, this free exhibition celebrates Kylie's contribution to music, stage and screen. Featuring an extensive display of costumes, accessories, photographs and audio-visual material from the entertainer's career.

Morris & Co

From 18th August

This is a rare opportunity to see one of the largest collections of Morris & Co furnishings outside of Britain. William Morris was one of the most influential British interior designers of the late 19th and early 20th centuries; his designs have been constantly revived and continue to be relevant today. This exhibition from the Art Gallery of South Australia features more than 100 pieces including furniture, carpets, tapestries, wallpapers and tiles from the heyday of Morris production in the 1880s and 90s.

The Cutting Edge Fashion from Japan

27th September – 29th January 2006

The cutting edge celebrates the experimentation, innovation and skill of Japanese fashion. It showcases 45 garments by leading designers including Issey Miyake, Rei Kawakubo and Yohji Yamamoto whose radical designs challenge Western conventions and introduce new aesthetics.

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AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT QUALITY TEACHER PROGRAM (AGQTP)

The AGQTP is a major Australian Government program for improving the quality of school teaching and leadership in Australia. In previous years, the program has provided funding to support a wide range of professional development activities including subsidised courses and conferences and action learning grant opportunities.

The Australian Government has recently announced that it is continuing to support teachers by providing funds for 2006-2009. This programme has 3 objectives:

- To equip teachers with the skills and knowledge needed for teaching in the 21st century.
- To provide national leadership in high priority areas

of teacher professional learning need.

- To improve the professional standing of school teachers and leaders.

The 2006-2009 AGQTP has identified 3 priority areas—curriculum, targeted learning needs and cross curricular/whole school initiatives. Once the Australian Government has approved the projects proposed by the independent sector, schools will be provided with details of the projects and information on how to apply for grants.
