TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Eligibility: The competition is open to all students enrolled in Independent primary and secondary schools throughout NSW.

Theme: The theme of the competition is Teachers: Empowering every student to shine. Artworks should showcase the remarkable role of teachers in inspiring and empowering their students. Students are encouraged to creatively and imaginatively depict the impact of teachers, whether by portraying an individual teacher who has inspired them or by representing teachers conceptually.

Categories: There are two categories for submissions: Primary (Years K-6) and Secondary (Years 7-12).

Medium: Participants may use any artistic medium, including but not limited to painting, drawing, sculpture, digital art, mixed media, and collage.

Submission Guidelines:

Artworks must be original and created solely by the student submitting the entry.

Schools are permitted to submit a maximum of TWO works from Primary and TWO works from Secondary.

Submissions should be accompanied by a brief artist's statement (maximum 100 words) explaining the inspiration behind the artwork.

Digital submissions should be high-resolution JPEG or PNG files. Physical artworks should be photographed or scanned for submission.

Submission Deadline: All entries must be submitted online by 5pm on Friday 27 June 2025 via this [link](#).

Judging Criteria: Entries will be judged based on creativity, interpretation of the theme, artistic skill, and overall impact.

Awards: Prizes will be awarded to the top entries in each category, including certificates and recognition on our organisation's website and social media channels.

Announcement of Winners: Schools will be notified via email and shortlisted students, parents and school delegates will be invited to attend the awards event, where winners will be announced.

Decision: All decisions made by the judging panel are final and binding.
