Schools now have several years for planning and preparation before implementation begins in 2027.

Schools may also wish to begin implementing some syllabuses prior to 2027. To support schools in this area, NESA has released <u>specific registration</u> <u>advice</u> for schools who plan to implement one or more syllabuses earlier than required.

AISNSW will be providing targeted support for schools throughout the three phases of the implementation period.



Familiarisation

School leaders and teachers are introduced to the new syllabus. Gaining an understanding of its organisational structure, key changes in outcomes and content, and provision of teaching and learning support materials are the focus of this phase.



Planning and Programming

Leaders and teachers work together to develop new school documentation (scope and sequences, units of learning) and provide additional resources that may be needed. Consideration is also given to assessment and reporting of student progress so they reflect the new syllabus outcomes and content.



Implementation

Teachers begin to teach, assess and report using the new syllabus. Monitoring and evaluation are ongoing to ensure the syllabus is effectively meeting its goals, with a focus on consistency and quality across the school.

Implementation Models

With four syllabuses to be implemented, each school will need to consider its own unique needs when making decisions about how they will best manage the planning and preparation period to ensure full implementation of all syllabuses by 2027.

Below are a number of scenarios that may be helpful in guiding schools in their own planning and preparation. These are not exhaustive; schools have flexibility to design an effective curriculum implementation strategy aligned to their own specific needs at the local level.
