### About the Research Activities:

The project includes a workshop for students and interviews with them afterward.

• We plan to co-design the workshop with schoolteachers to align project initiatives with the school curriculum and transdisciplinary pedagogical practices.

• We plan to have one workshop for 20-25 students from one year group (Year 7-Year 9). We'll choose the year group based on what you think is best to be involved in the project.

- a. The workshop will be about 90 minutes long, with a short break.
- b. Interviews with students will last 20-30 minutes each.
