

# AISNSW TEACHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

# **Overview**

The AISNSW Teacher Education Scholarship is a merit-based academic scholarship for an undergraduate Bachelor of Education or Master of Teaching student who wants to contribute to the rich learning of students in the Independent education sector. The successful candidate will be in their **final year of study** and receive the 12-month AISNSW Teacher Education Scholarship to work in a participating Independent school. The scholarship offers:

- a remission of university tuition fees in the final year of study valued at \$10,000 (paid at end of Term One, 2025) upon successful completion of their degree and presentation of executed full-time employment contract with an Independent school.
- a paid internship in an Independent member school located, to be negotiated, for:
  - $\circ$  one day per week (or equivalent) during Terms 1-3, 2024
  - equivalent of four days per week during Term 4, 2024.

### **Eligibility**

This Scholarship will be awarded to a student with an excellent academic record who will contribute to the curricular and co-curricular life within the Independent school and be supportive of its ethos. To be eligible for this scholarship the student must be enrolled full-time in their final year in 2024 in one of the following degrees:

- Master of Teaching (Early Childhood)
- Master of Teaching (Primary Education)
- Master of Teaching (Secondary Education)
- Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood)
- Bachelor of Education (Primary Education)
- Bachelor of Education (Secondary Education)

The Candidate will:

- take part in the school's onboarding and induction process
- undertake a paid internship at an Independent school for one day a week during Terms 1-3, and the equivalent of four days per week during Term 4
- receive guidance from a trained mentor teacher allocated by the school
- commit to working in the Independent sector beyond the completion of the degree
- provide AISNSW with evidence of full-time employment with in Independent school.



# **Selection criteria**

Applications will be assessed against two selection criteria: **academic achievement** and **personal statement**. The Scholarship will be awarded to the most suitable applicant across the two categories:

- **Personal statement** (maximum 500 words) outlining your interest in applying for the AISNSW Teacher Education Scholarship including any specific qualities or experience you feel are relevant. See the rubric attached.
- High academic achievement in core subjects (based on 2022/2023 academic transcripts).

# **Selection Process**

#### Eligibility check and assessment of applications

- After the closing date, applications will be checked for eligibility.
- A Selection Panel, comprising AISNSW staff and Independent school representatives, will independently assess and score applications against Selection Criteria.
- Shortlisted applicants will provide contact details for two referees one of whom must be from the university.

#### Finalist interviews, referee, and due diligence checks

- Finalists will be invited to attend an interview with the Selection Panel.
- Referees will be contacted for reference checks.
- A Working with Children Check, due diligence, and background checks on finalists will be undertaken.
- The Selection Panel will discern the final Scholarship recipient.

#### Announcement of Award recipients

• The Scholarship recipient will be notified following the Selection Panel deliberations.
