TERMS AND COMMITMENTS

- 1. Eligibility criteria. To be eligible for the Scholarship recipient, you must be an AISNSW member school.
- 2. School selection. The placement of the Scholarship recipient will be based on the best fit between the school's location and employment needs, and the suitability and employment preferences of the Scholarship recipient.
- 3. Employment options. If more than one school matches the Scholarship recipient's location and degree specialisation, then the Scholarship recipient will make the final selection as to place of employment. AISNSW will not enter into further negotiations.





- 4. Duration of employment. The school commits to employing the Scholarship recipient for a minimum of 4 terms/12 months. They must be provided with **employment** at least 1 day per week in Terms 1 to 3, and 4 days per week in Term 4, in accordance with the *Independent Schools NSW (Support and Operational Staff) Multi-Enterprise Agreement* 2021.
- 5. Mentoring. The school commits to allocating an existing staff member as a Mentor for the AISNSW Scholarship recipient. This staff member will complete the <u>Being an Effective</u> <u>Mentor</u> self-paced course.
- 6. Early Career. If the AISNSW Scholarship recipient is employed on a full-time basis following competition of their studies, the school agrees to register them in the <u>Early Career Experience</u> two-year course.
- 7. Continuation of Employment. The initial contract of employment for the Scholarship recipient is for 4 terms/12 months. Any extension of the contract beyond that is the responsibility of the school and the Scholarship recipient.
