

# Distance Learning at Wenona

## Guidelines for Students (Years K-4)

### 1. What will the day look like?

- Start at 8:20am with a check in
- Try to follow the school day as much as possible
- Take a break for recess and lunch
- Finish the day with a questionnaire

### 2. Where should I do my work?

- Find a quiet space where you can work
- If you are using video, move to a space outside your bedroom and make sure you are wearing your Wenona Sport or House T-Shirt

### 3. How do I talk to my teacher?

- Each morning, your teacher will send your parents an email or post new tasks on Canvas
- Ask your parents/guardians to read the email or help you to login to Canvas so you can get your tasks for the day
- Check if there are any planned videoconferences or class discussion times
- If you have any questions about your work, you can email your teacher

### 4. Let us know how you're doing.

- At the end of each day complete a short questionnaire to let us know how you are feeling about your learning
- Check in with your parents at the end of the day to discuss your learning and any questions you might have
