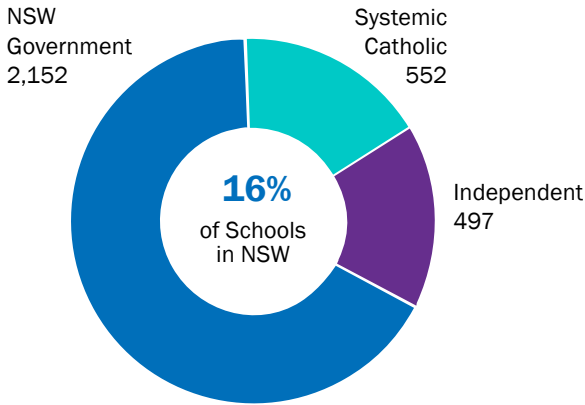




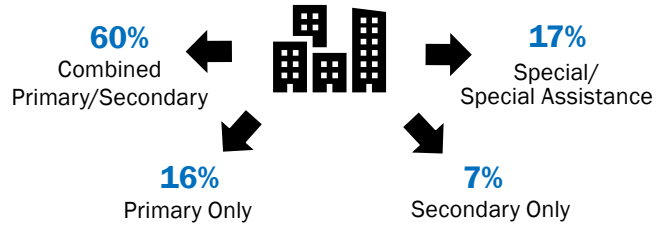
NSW Independent Schools *at a glance* 2019

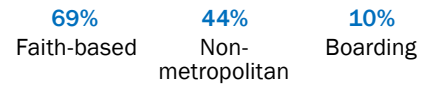

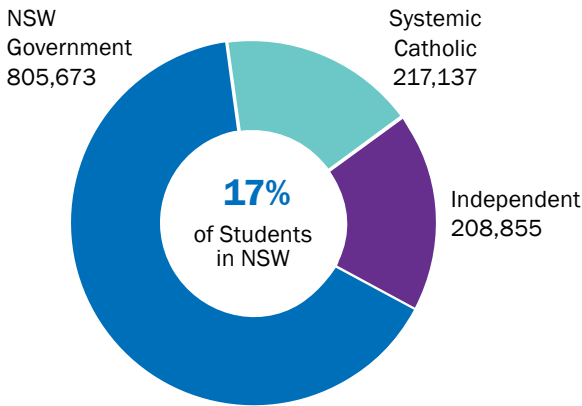

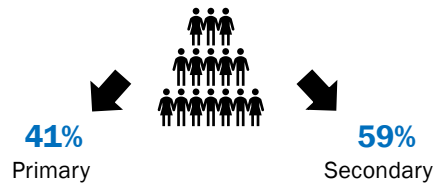
Types of Independent Schools

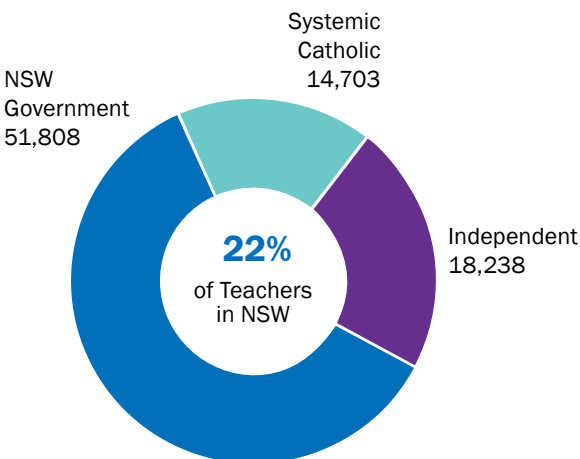

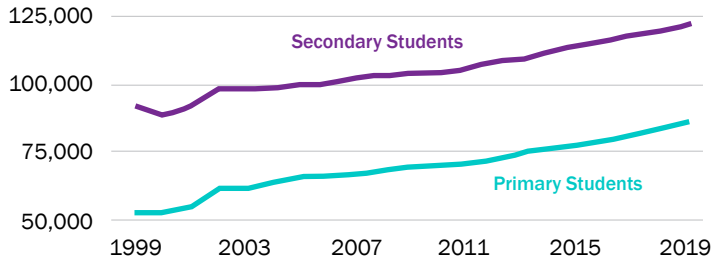

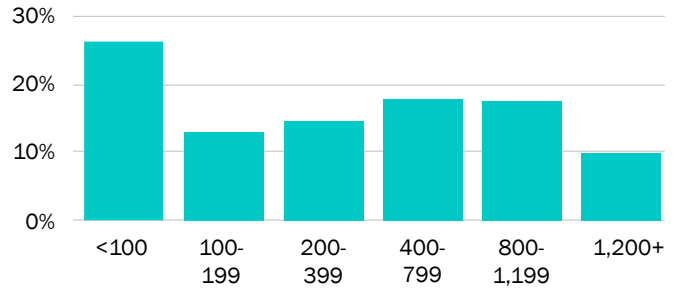

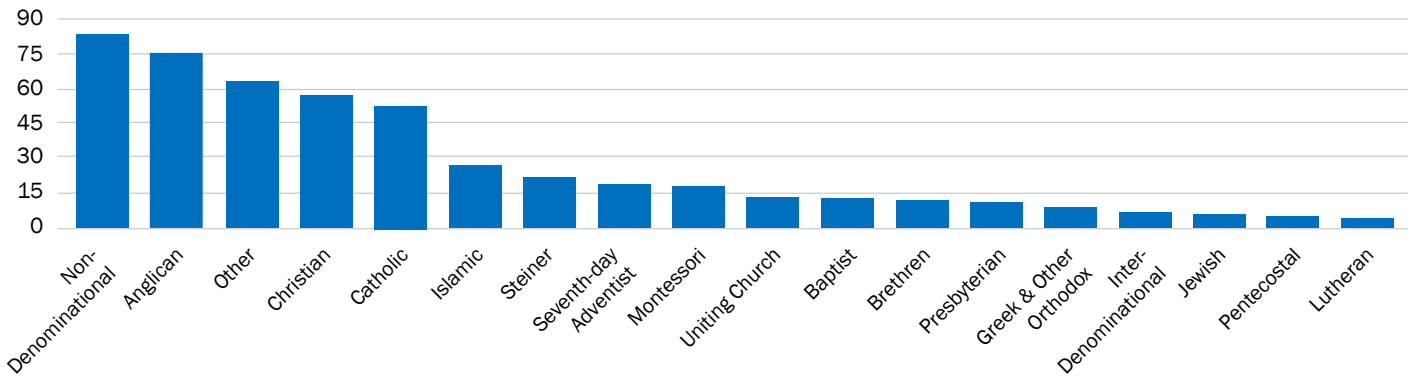
Students in Independent Schools



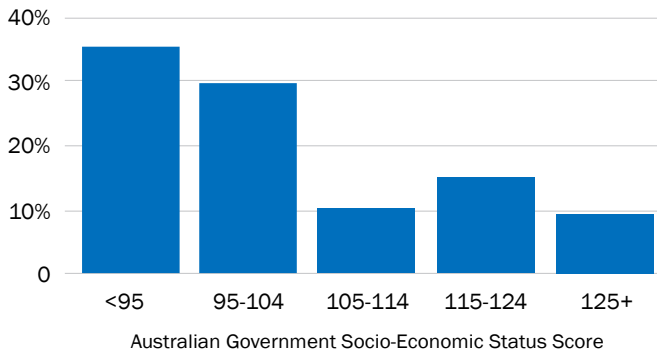
Percentage of Independent Schools by Enrolment Size



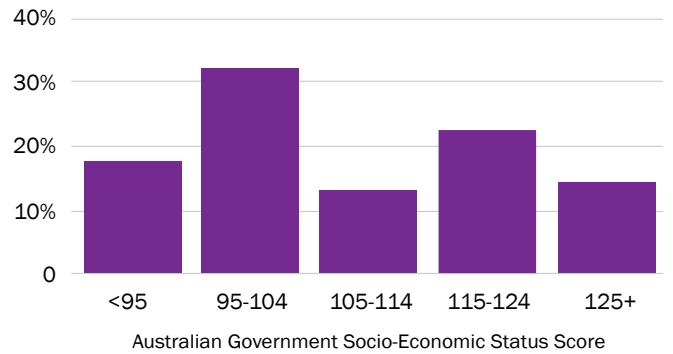
Number of Schools by Affiliation



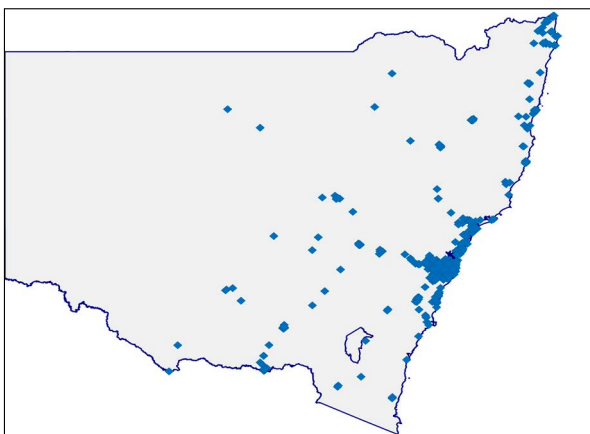
Socio-Economic Diversity of Schools
