LATEST AVAILABLE FACTS AND FIGURES

245,452 STUDENTS

One in five NSW students (20%) attends an Independent school, up from one in ten in 1990.



## 2.0% **ANNUAL GROWTH**

NSW Independent school enrolments are forecast

to grow by 2% per year for the next decade compared with 0.6% for all sectors.



### 430 SCHOOLS

NSW has 430 Independent schools on 573 campuses. Half are K-12 schools.



#### 15+ DIFFERENT FAITHS

70% of NSW Independent schools are faith based

with more than 15 faiths represented. 92 schools are secular.



# 45% SMALL SCHOOLS

Almost half of NSW Independent schools have fewer than 250 students. Only 3% have more than 2,000 students.



## \$5,989 **MEDIAN FEE**

Half of NSW Independent schools charge fees of \$6,000 or less per year. More schools charge less than \$2,000 per year than charge \$20,000 per year.

#### LOW-MEDIUM INCOME FAMILIES

Most students in NSW Independent schools are from low to middle income families.



## 67 SPECIAL NEEDS SCHOOLS

In NSW, 67 Independent Special and Special Assistance Schools operate across 150 locations, enrolling 6.511 students.



# 1 in 3 LBOTE

One in three students in NSW Independent schools has a language άA background other than English.



#### 132 **REGIONAL SCHOOLS**

Almost one in three NSW Independent schools are located in regional areas.



## \$3.9 billion PARENT CONTRIBUTIONS

On average, parents fund just over half the cost of educating a child in **NSW Independent** schools and 90% of building costs, saving taxpayers billions of dollars each year.



## 6,468 FIRST NATIONS STUDENTS

Enrolment of Aboriginal and **Torres Strait Islander students** in NSW Independent

schools has grown by an average of 8.4% per year for the past five years.
