Behaviour Tally | FACT SHEET

Purpose

A tally is an easy and helpful way to quantify the behaviours of high frequency. It records each instance of the behaviour during a set timeframe.

When to use

This method of recording is ideal for behaviours that have a clear beginning and end, such as calling out, or raising a hand. It can document the pattern of the behaviour over time, and the rate per minute or hour can easily be calculated.

How to use

On a tally sheet each occurrence of the behaviour is recorded by the class teacher(s), noting the period during which the count is taking place.
